Guess the Object!



This is a fun game that you can play at anytime, but when Santa has just delivered all those new toys, this is a great opportunity to talk about less familiar objects.

The idea of the game is for the adult to give the child a clue as to what they are thinking of eg: I'm thinking of something that is brown and lives in the woods and flies - (owl).

I'm thinking of a fruit and it has yellow skin that you peel - (a banana).

Make it easier:

- Have the objects in view.
- Increase the number of clues that your child listens to.

Make it harder:

- Reduce the clues.
- Consider objects that are not in view.
- Choose items according to their function or location/can have multiple uses eg: Something that cuts (knife/scissors)
- Let your child give the clues and the adult guesses.
