## 'Sticks and Stones'



## Outdoor fun!

Collect lots of sticks and stones.

Line up the sticks in order of size. Talk about which stick is the *longest* and which is the *shortest*.

Look at the stones that you have collected.

Talk about which is the biggest, the smallest, the heaviest, the lightest.

Are they shiny or dull, rough or smooth?

Choose a favourite stone and say why you like it best.

Use the sticks and stones to make a picture on the ground.

Make it easier: Collect just 2 sticks and stones to compare. Use only the words 'biggest' and 'smallest' when describing them.

Make it harder: Compare two sticks or stones. Encourage your child to make up sentences about them using the words 'longer than' or 'shorter than', 'bigger than' or 'smaller than', 'heavier than' or 'lighter than'.
