## Swat that picture!



Use any picture cards you have, such as snap or memory game. Check your child recognises each picture, for example, ask 'Where's the $\qquad$ ?' Ask your child to tap the picture with their finger.

When you have checked your child recognises each picture, ask them to 'swat' 2 or 3 pictures. You can use any safe object, for example, a teddy bear's paw or a feather duster. Can your child identify the 2 or 3 pictures in the correct order?

For example: cat, cup, cap.


Make it easier:

- Start with up to 5 cards or pictures in total. Ask your child to swat 2 or 3 of them.

Make it harder:

- Increase the number of pictures in front of your child (see above) and increase the number to swat to 4 or 5.
- Add a waiting time. You say the list of picture names, for example, apple, tree, cake. Your child has to wait for up to 5 seconds until you say 'Ready, steady, go,' before pointing to the pictures. Can your child point to the pictures in the correct order?
