

52 Things to Support your Child's

Speech and Language Skills.

Is it a fruit or is it a vegetable?

You will need:

- Paper cups, glue
- Pictures of fruit and vegetables from supermarket leaflets or draw your own. Then stick the pictures on the cups.
- Stack all the cups together.
- Take it in turns to choose a cup from the top.
- Look at the picture and name the fruit/vegetable and decide...

"Is it a vegetable?"

or

"Is it a fruit?"



**Make a tower of fruit and a tower of vegetables,
then have fun knocking the towers down.**

Make it easier: If your child doesn't know the categories yet, you may need to support by providing fruit and vegetable posters.

Make it harder: Extend further by discussing the shape, size and where it is grown etc.
