Easter Egg Hunt:

Get ready for an old fashioned Easter Egg Hunt.....

Things you may need: Plastic, Card or Chocolate Easter Eggs.



This activity requires lots of listening, hide 6 eggs in and around a room or outside, make sure that they are positioned as follows: On/Under, In front/Behind, Above/Below. Give your child clear instructions as to where to find them one at a time, e.g. It's under a flower pot.

<u>Make it Easier:</u> Hide one egg at a time, changing the location, but sticking with same idea, e.g. putting it <u>under</u> something.

<u>Make it Harder:</u> Using the same amount of eggs, use language such as <u>left</u> and <u>right</u>. Ensuring your child knows their <u>left</u> from their <u>right</u>.
