Big Ted, Little Ted.

Play this game to help your child learn to follow short instructions that involve the words 'first' and 'last'.

You will need a big and little soft toy and a sponge or a flannel. Tell your child that you are going to pretend to give the teddies a bath. Give your child instructions to wash different parts of the bear's body using the words;

'first' and 'last'.

"Wash little teddy's tummy first and then his toes last."

"Wash big teddy's nose first and then his ears last."



Let your child be teacher and tell you what to do. You may have to remind your child to tell you both instructions in one sentence.

Make it easier:

• Get your child to copy you doing the actions first.

Make it harder:

• Introduce more toys and a towel to dry parts of the teddy's body.
