Pronouns in play





For this activity you will need some toy figures and a play set. For example, Lego, Dolls house furniture, vehicles, train set etc.

Whilst playing with your child, encourage them to use the correct pronoun for 'he' and 'she'. You could make comments for them to listen to, such as, "She is driving the car." or "He is sitting on the chair." You could also ask your child "Who is sleeping?" and help your child answer "he is" or "she is". Praise your child when they use the correct pronoun. "You're right, he is sleeping. Well done!"

Make it easier: Model use of pronouns for your child to repeat after you.

Make it harder: Introduce the pronoun 'they' for a group of play people who are doing the same thing. For example, "They are sailing in the boat." Encourage your child to use 'they' correctly in their play.
