Bonfire night is always an exciting time. So dress up warmly and go outside and listen to some of the fantastic sounds you can hear.

Try and mimic the sounds you can hear with your child - whoosh, whizz, whoow, bang, zip, hmmmm, boom, hiss, crackle, fizz etc

Talk about the sounds you are making.

- Are they long sounds?
 'hisssssssss', 'whooooosh'
- Or are they short sounds?
 'bang', 'zip'
- Are they quiet sounds?
 'Hmmmmmmm'
- Or are they noisy sounds?
 'bang', 'boom'

Make it easier: Ask your child to copy your sound but in a loud voice, a quiet voice, a crackly voice or a smooth voice.

Make it harder: use the sounds you have made in a sentence.

How many words can you get into one sentence?

'The **hissing** sparkler **crackled** and **fizzed** before it went **bang**.' Can you beat 4?
