

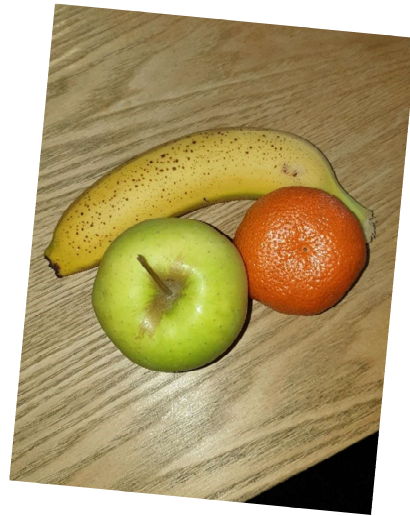
52 Things to Support your Child's

Speech and Language Skills.

Indoor Scavenger Hunt!

Set the children on a scavenger hunt around the house. A scavenger hunt is similar to a treasure hunt. The idea is that you give the children a list or name some items they need to collect from around the home. You could time older children or have a hunt in each room around the house.

Safety note: Ensure children are supervised whilst looking for the items and that the things you are asking the children to find are child friendly and are in a safe place for the children to access. Specifically using toys would be a good option.



Make it easier: Ask the child to collect 5 items they are familiar with. For example a teddy, toothbrush, hat, cushion, shoe or 5 familiar toys.

Make it harder: Ask the child to collect a number of items from a category. For example 3 things we wear (hat, shoe, sock), 3 pieces of fruit (apple, banana, orange) etc.
