Who, what and where?

You will need some soft toys, bags and some pictures for this game. Put the soft toys around the room with a bag each. Draw some pictures of treasure and put them in front of your child.





Tell your child that the toys are hiding the treasure. Ask your child to close their eyes and take one of the photos and put it in one of the soft toy's bags.

Ask your child to open their eyes and look at the treasure pictures, then ask "What is missing?"

Once your child knows what to look for let him/her go and find the missing picture." Now ask...

<u>"who</u> took it?" and "<u>where</u> did you find it?"

Make it easier: To make this game easier just work on 'who' and 'what is'

Make it harder: to make this game harder use more toys and more treasure.
