
52 Things to Support your Child's

Speech and Language Skills.



This game is to help your child to follow short instructions that involve the key words *first, then and last.* You will need:

- Colouring pencils
- Paper



Give your child instructions to follow using the words *first, then* and *last*.

Eg. <u>"First</u> draw a car and <u>then</u> colour it blue."

Now, draw a sun and a moon. Colour the moon in last.

Ask your child to be a teacher and give you instructions to follow. Ask your child to tell you what to draw and the order to draw them in, encouraging them to tell you both things in one sentence.

Make deliberate mistakes and see if your child can spot them.

Make it easier: ask your child to copy your model.

Make it harder: give your child longer instructions.
