

52 Things to Support your Child's

Speech and Language Skills.



Story Time.

Share stories with your child and their favourite cuddly toy. Sharing stories helps to support and develop your child's language skills.

Make it easier -

- Look at the pictures and discuss what you can see. Ask your child to tell you and their cuddly toy what is happening?
- Ask your child to point to various things on the page. Where is the dog? Bus? Extend by asking them to find the orange flower, blue car or the boy who is running.

Make it harder -

- Talk about how the characters are feeling.
- Can your child predict what might happen next?
- Can your child retell the story to their cuddly toy by telling them what happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story?

Sharing books with your child either by looking at the pictures together or by them listening to you read will expose your child to many new words and vocabulary.
