The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Marsh Lane, Hampton in Arden) (Total Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, The Core, Theatre Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via www.solihull.gov.uk/Resident/Parking-travel-roads/roadworks-and-restrictions/tros A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 14 January 2021, will introduce the following:

Prohibition of Driving

Marsh Lane – from a point approximately 73 metres east of its junction with Bellemere Road, south-eastwards for a total distance of approximately 655 metres.

Specified Periods of Operation:

1st April - 30th September inclusive, between 2100hrs – 0700hrs

1st October - 31st March inclusive, between 1800hrs – 0800hrs

Exemptions:

Access for cyclists, pedestrians, horse riders, emergency services and adjacent land owners will be maintained at all times.
