The Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The proposals are:

Proposed Prohibition of Driving

Marsh Lane – from a point approximately 73 metres east of its junction with Bellemere Road, south-eastwards for the remainder of its length. A total distance of approximately 655 metres.

Specified Periods of Operation:

1st April - 30th September inclusive, between 2100hrs – 0700hrs

1st October - 31st March inclusive, between 1800hrs – 0800hrs

Exemptions:

Access for cyclists, pedestrians, horse riders, emergency services and adjacent land owners will be maintained at all times.
