Supporting Early Identification and Intervention

Solihull's Early Years Support & Assessment Team (EYSAT) has a home visiting educational support service. It supports children's development by helping parents and children to play and learn together

It is available for families who reside in Solihull and have a child who has been accepted by the TAC panel

We aim to:-

- Provide support, advice and guidance to enable parents to acquire the skills necessary to promote their child's development
- Celebrate the child's achievements
- Develop strong partnerships with parents and other professionals
- Signpost families to relevant services
- Support the transition of children with additional needs into early years provision

What do our home visiting team do?

The home visiting team practitioner will focus on the development of play, communication, relationships and learning. They visit children and their families at home, working in partnership with parents or carers. EYSAT home visitors will use information from parents, observations and appropriate assessment tools to identify goals for future learning. EYSAT home visitors work closely with the EYSAT Area SENCo team and other multi agency practitioners.
