The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Dorridge Fun Run) (Road Closures and Total Prohibition of Waiting) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994 and being satisfied that the traffic on the roads listed below should be restricted or prohibited in the interests of public safety to event participants:

Temporary Road Closures - 07:00hrs until 15:00hrs on Sunday 12th June 2022

1. Manor Road, Dorridge - from Rodborough Road to Grange Road.
2. Station Road, Dorridge - from Manor Road to Station Approach.
3. Station Approach, Dorridge - from Station Road to Dorridge Road.
4. Dorridge Road, Dorridge - from Station Approach to Blue Lake Road.
5. Blue Lake Road, Dorridge - from Dorridge Road to Darley Green Road.
6. Darley Green Road, Knowle - from Blue Lake Road to Packwood Road.
7. Bakers Lane, Dorridge - from Darley Green Road to the Solihull Boundary.
8. Packwood Road, Dorridge - from the Solihull Boundary to Darley Green Road.
9. Vicarage Road, Dorridge - from Packwood Road to Windmill Lane.
10. Windmill Lane, Dorridge - from Vicarage Road to Grange Road.
11. Grange Road, Dorridge - from Windmill Lane to Manor Road.

Diversion for all traffic shall follow Station Road, Grove Road, Warwick Road, Rising Lane, Mill Lane, Old Warwick Road, Stratford Road, Box Trees Road, Four Ashes Road, Mill Lane and Poplar Road. Vice versa for the other direction.

Temporary Total Prohibition of Waiting - Thursday 9th June at 20:00hrs until Sunday 12th June 2022 at 15:00hrs

1. Manor Road, Dorridge - from Cawdon Grove to Grange Road.
2. Station Approach, Dorridge - from Dorridge Road to Station Road.

Access for emergency services will be maintained through the restriction at defined points by contacting a Course Marshal. Pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of closure.
