The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Caldwell Grove, Solihull) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2022

The Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The proposals are:

Proposed Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time

Caldwell Grove (eastern side) - from a point approximately 19 metres south of its junction with Hermitage Road, south-eastwards for 67 metres.

Caldwell Grove (northern side) - from a point approximately 133 metres south-east of its junction with Hermitage Road, south-eastwards for 24 metres.

Caldwell Grove (northern side) - from a point approximately 210 metres south-east of its junction with Hermitage Road in a generally easterly direction for 32 metres.

Caldwell Grove (eastern side) - from a point approximately 358 metres south-east of its junction with Hermitage Road in a generally southerly, then north-westerly direction for 30 metres.

Caldwell Grove (western side) - from a point approximately 19 metres south of its junction with Hermitage Road, in a generally south-easterly direction for 367 metres.
