The Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council (Parish of Barston) (Footpath M126A) Definitive Map Modification Order 2022

The above Order made on 18th July,2022 under Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

Adding a footpath from Oak Lane Farm, Barston to Ryton End Lane:

Commences at the eastern end of the sealed-surface length of Oak Lane at the entrance to Oak Lane Farm (at OS Grid Ref SP 20886,78728) at Point A on the attached plan. The Footpath leads in a north-easterly direction through a boundary into the garden of a barn conversion dwelling to another boundary at Point B (at OS Grid Ref SP 20945,78749) then leads through a small field beyond to a further boundary at Point C (at OS Grid Ref SP 21034,78786) following the south side of the northern boundaries. The footpath then continues in the same north-easterly direction within a larger field to Point D (at OS Grid Ref SP 21200,78850) where it turns in an easterly direction to lead to another boundary and a watercourse at Point E (at OS Grid Ref SP 21310,78844) and continues in the same easterly direction across a further field to Point F at a junction with Ryton End Lane (at OS Grid Ref SP 21497,78820). Total length is approximately 640 metres. Width is: 2 metres from the start point (at OS Grid Ref SP 20886,78728) to the end point at the junction with Ryton End Lane (at OS Grid Ref SP 21497,78820).
