Windward Way, Smith's Wood Proposed Traffic Calming Measures (Speed Cushions) and Establishment of New Parallel Pedestrian Crossing

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council, in accordance with Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 and in accordance with Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, intends to construct the following traffic calming measures and commission a new parallel pedestrian crossing facility at the location specified below:

Windward Way, Smith's Wood – a pair of speed cushions located approximately 40m west of its junction with Buckingham Road.	Width: 1.8m	Height: 75mm	Length: 3.5m
Windward Way, Smith's Wood – a new parallel pedestrian crossing located just to the east of its junction with Buckingham Road.
