

EY TAC (Early Years Team Around the Child) Process REFERRAL ROUTE 2 (Solihull Early Education Provision only)

Child 0-4yrs

Solihull setting is concerned about emerging SEND and there is no current involvement from Specialist Inclusion Support Service (SISS)/Area SENCo



If the child attends a group-setting
The setting notifies the **AREA SENCo** of concerns after a period of Graduated Approach
Ensure parental consent is agreed for the referral

If a childminder wishes to make a referral for additional home support from the Early Years Inclusion Support Practitioner
Complete the EY TAC form – you should have consent from parents to complete this form to request support. It is recommended to liaise with the health visitor with parental consent.
