

SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Catherine de Barnes Lane, Solihull) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023

The Council gives notice that it has varied the duration and extents of the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety:

Locations:

1. Catherine de Barnes Lane – between its junction with the Birmingham Dogs Home to its junction with Bickenhill Lane.
2. Catherine de Barnes Lane – from a point approx. 75m south of its southern junction with St Peters Lane to its northern junction with St Peters Lane.

Date(s) and time(s) when restriction will apply: ongoing until 31st May 2024 at 23:59hrs.

Diversion routes: Signed via Catherine-de-Barnes Lane, A45 to Damson Parkway, Yew Tree Lane, Hampton Lane and Shadowbrook Lane.

Reason for restriction: Excavation and construction.

Works on behalf of: Skanska.

Access **cannot** be provided through the restriction for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies.

Pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of closure.
