

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary Election for the Meriden and Solihull East Constituency

1. An Election is to be held of a Member of Parliament to serve Meriden and Solihull East.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at Electoral Services, Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Electoral Services, Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.
4. The required deposit (£500) may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender (cash in British pounds only), by means of a banker's draft or, by electronic transfer (BACS), as below

5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB by 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024. 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. 9. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote.
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
