The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Catherine de Barnes Lane, Solihull) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023

The Council gives notice that it has further varied the duration of the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety:

Locations:

1. **Ongoing until 27 September 2024 at 23.59hrs** - Catherine de Barnes Lane – between its junction with the Birmingham Dogs Home to its junction with Bickenhill Lane.
2. **Ongoing until 27 September 2024 at 23.59hrs** - Catherine de Barnes Lane – from a point approx. 75m south of its southern junction with St Peters Lane to its northern junction with St Peters Lane.
3. **00.01hrs on 31 August 2024 until 30 November 2024 at 23.59hrs** - Catherine de Barnes Lane – from its junction with Church Lane to its junction with Clock Lane.

Diversion routes: Signed via Catherine-de-Barnes Lane, A45 to Damson Parkway, Yew Tree Lane, Hampton Lane and Shadowbrook Lane.

Reason for restriction: Excavation and construction.

Works on behalf of: Skanska.

Access **cannot** be provided through the restriction for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies.

Pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of closure.
