The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Arleston Way & Cranmore Avenue, Solihull) (Total Prohibition and Restriction Waiting) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The draft Order and reasons for making it can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by visiting Solihull Connect, The Core, Theatre Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare/Traffic-regulation-orders>. To support or object to the above Order, please write to Mr L Stevenson, Legal & Democratic Services Division, at the address below stating the reasons by no later than 18 October 2024. The proposals are:

Proposed Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time

Arleston Way - From a point 17 metres south-east of its junction with Cranmore Avenue, in a south easterly direction to a point 90 metres south-east of that junction on the northern side of the road.

Cranmore Avenue – (i) From a point 14 metres south-west of its junction with Cranmore Drive, in a south westerly direction, to a point 96 metres south-west of that junction on the western side of the road; and (ii) From a point 110 metres south-west of its junction with Cranmore Drive, in a south westerly direction, to a point 158 metres south-west of that junction on the western side of the road.

Proposed Restriction of Waiting – Monday to Sunday (Overnight) 8.00pm to 8.00am

Cranmore Avenue - From a point 96 metres south-west of its junction with Cranmore Drive, in a south westerly direction to a point 110 metres south-west of that junction on the western side of the road.
