The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Mews & Over Green Drive, Kingshurst) (Total Prohibition Waiting) Order 2024

Statement of Reasons

Mews is a new residential cul-de-sac which has been constructed as part of the Kingshurst Village redevelopment.

Double yellow lines will be introduced on Mews, for its entire length, as part of the agreed Section 38 works for the development The parking restriction will prevent vehicles parking in a manner which creates an obstruction and impedes access for larger vehicles, such as refuse vehicles, in the future.

Double yellow lines will be introduced at the junction of Over Green Drive & Mews to ensure drivers have an adequate visibility splay.

Mews can be considered for formal adoption by the highway authority upon the introduction of the double yellow lines.

It is recommended that the proposals are advertised as shown on drawing no.'s. M00513-BML-XX-S38-DR-C-1200 C04 & M00513-BML-XX-DR-C-1250 C02.

The Ward Members for Kingshurst & Fordbridge and Smiths wood have been advised of the proposed traffic regulation order for Mews.
