The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Sharmans Cross Road, Solihull) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The proposals are:

Proposed Restriction of Waiting – No Waiting Monday to Friday – 8.30am to 9.30am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm

Sharmans Cross Road (south-eastern side) -

1. From a point approximately 25m north-east of Prospect Lane, in a north-easterly direction, for a distance of approximately 40 metres.
2. From a point approximately 90m north-east of Prospect Lane, in a north-easterly direction, for a distance of approximately 25 metres.
3. From a point approximately 140m north-east of Prospect Lane, in a north-easterly direction, for a distance of approximately 25 metres.
4. From a point approximately 190m north-east of Prospect Lane, in a north-easterly direction, for a distance of approximately 25 metres.
5. From a point approximately 67m northeast of the boundary wall of Sharmans Cross Junior School, for a distance of approximately 25m, in a north-westerly direction.
6. From a point approximately 117m northeast of the boundary wall of Sharmans Cross Junior School, for a distance of approximately 25m, in a north-westerly direction.
7. From a point approximately 167m northeast of the boundary wall of Sharmans Cross Junior School, for a distance of approximately 25m, in a north-westerly direction.
8. From a point approximately 8m north east of the south western extended kerb line of Woodside Way, south westwards, for a distance of approximately 25m.
9. From a point approximately 50m south east of the south western extended kerb line of Woodside Way, south westwards, for a distance of approximately 25m.
