The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Mews & Over Green Drive, Kingshurst) (Total Prohibition Waiting) Order 2024

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare/Traffic-regulation-orders>. A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 8 November 2024, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time

Mews - From its junction with Over Green Drive, in a westerly direction, to its cul-de-sac end (entire length) on both sides of the road.

Over Green Drive - From a point 15 metres north of its junction with Mews, in a southerly direction, to a point 15 metres south of that junction on the western side of the road.

Revocation of Existing Waiting Restrictions – Monday to Saturday 9.00am to 7.00pm

Over Green Drive - From a point 15 metres north of its junction with Mews, in a southerly direction, to a point 15 metres south of that junction on the western side of the road.
