EY TAC (Early Years Team Around the Child) Process Decision Making Guidance (Health teams/childminders)

Child 0-4yrs Criteria for referral to EY TAC -

- □ Is the child pre-school age?
- □ Do they meet these criteria?
- Do you have parental consent?
- **3 or more** areas of significant developmental delay (communication, fine & gross motor skills, sensory, problem solving/learning/play, personal & social linked to ASQ and early years child development)
- 0 2 years: 6-month delay in at least 3 areas
- 2 3 years: 6-12 months delay in at least 3 areas
- 3 years+ school entry: 12-month delay in at least 3 areas



What support does the child need?

□ Early Years Team - home support in either a parent/ carer's home or a child minder home.

Children are supported in their home by an Early Years Inclusion Support Practitioner or Early Years Area SENCo in setting – but not usually both.

Or

SISS: Sensory and Physical Impairment- does the child have a physical disability, a hearing impairment, visual impairment, or multi-sensory impairment?

And/or

□ Solihull Speech and Language Therapy where the child may be experiencing difficulties with communication.
