A huge thank you to everyone who joined in our Celebration Event on 3rd December 2024. It was a truly special evening dedicated to celebrating the successes of children, young people, adults and organisations in Solihull.

96 children and young people were nominated for a range of awards by their current or previous school – in the categories of child or young person of the year, young carer, kindness, bravery, leadership and achievement.

93 school staff were also nominated by children and young people, or their families, for a SEND Champion award, and services were able to nominate a SEND organisation.

It was an honour to read through all of the nominations and hear about all of the strengths of our children and young people with SEND in Solihull and those who support them. We have so many amazing children and young people, with wonderful life stories and it was extremely difficult to shortlist.
