The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Cheswick Green Village – Various Roads) (Total Prohibition of Waiting, Restriction of Waiting and Limited Waiting) Order 2024 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2024

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 14 February 2025, will introduce the following:

Total Prohibition of Waiting – At Any Time

Foxland Close (north-west side) - From a point approx. 41m north-east of its junction with Glenwood Drive, south-westwards for approx. 56m.

Foxland Close (south-east side) - From a point approx. 28m north-east of its junction with Briarwood Close, south-westwards for approx. 58m.
