Notes

There will be 3 virtual sessions per day of approximately 1.5 hours per session.

There will be a morning break of around 20 mins after the first 1.5 hour session.

A lunch break will be taken normally between 13.00 - 14.00 each day.

This format can be reviewed and further breaks introduced if necessary to reduce eye fatigue.

The final session of the day will finish at around 15.30.

Site visit date will be confirmed.

* Landscape evidence

The agreements in the SoCG are noted. Issues relating to Green Belt / Grey Belt will be dealt with through the formal planning evidence. There is a cross-over with the landscape evidence and during this session the Inspector will seek the witnesses views on the physical impact of the development on character / appearance / openness and relevant purposes. One 1.5 hour session will be sufficient for this purpose.

* Planning evidence

The Council's strong preference for the planning evidence to be heard in person rather than virtually is noted. However, given the timetable for the first week, it appears likely that the planning evidence would begin on Friday 17th. It would not be appropriate to delay this until the following week as this would result in a wasted inquiry day on the first week. The Council's witness would be heard first and would therefore need to be heard in the virtual format, likely to be on Friday 17th. In order to ensure parity, the Appellants' witness would also be heard virtually provisionally beginning on week 2.

Furthermore at this stage, due to ongoing personal issues, it is not possible for the Inspector to confirm that she will be able to attend the inquiry in person on the second week. It is hoped (but cannot be guaranteed) that this will become clearer during the first week of the inquiry if not before.
