Introducing soft plastic recycling

You can now recycle plastic films and wrappers in your recycling. Please place these loose into your brown bin, communal recycling bin or clear sack. **Alongside your normal recycling you can now include:**

Do not overfill your green bin. Very heavy bins can cause problems when placed onto the vehicle lift. As a general rule your garden waste bin should be easily moved using one hand.

Do the right thing

As a householder you have a duty of care to ensure that you dispose of your rubbish correctly and legally. You can help to do this by following the guidance below, if you need more information, please contact us or check out the information on our website.

- Please make sure your recycling and rubbish containers are put out by 6am on your collection day. The earliest you can put them out is the evening before collection.
- Once emptied, containers should be returned to your property as soon as possible. Please do not leave your containers out on footpaths or roads.
- Only rubbish placed in the containers/ purple sacks provided will be collected.
 We will not remove rubbish left outside your bin or in black sacks.

 Please help to keep your streets clean by not putting out extra rubbish – leaving rubbish and other items on the street is fly-tipping.
