Various Roads, Solihull (Carriageway Works) Notice of Temporary Road Closures

The Council gives notice under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety along:

St Peters Lane, Bickenhill – Between Church Lane and property “Hazel Farm” on Monday 17th February 2025 between 08:00 and 16:00hrs. Alternative routes via St Peters Lane, Catherine de Barnes Lane and Church Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction.

Rumbush Lane, Earlswood – Between Tanners Green Lane and Wood Lane on Wednesday 12th March 2025 between 09:30 and 15:30hrs. Alternative routes via Rumbush Lane, Norton Lane, Valley Road, B4102, B4101 and Poolhead Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction.

Harvest Hill Lane, Meriden – Between Shaft Lane and Oak Lane on Wednesday 12th March 2025 between 08:00 and 16:00hrs. Alternative routes via Becks Lane, Fillongley Road, Wall Hill Road, Bridle Brook Lane and Oak Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction.

Longbrook Lane, Temple Balsall – Between Fernhill Lane and Balsall Street on Monday 31st March 2025 between 08:00 and 16:00hrd. Alternative routes via Balsall Street and Fernhill Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction.

Reason for restriction: Carriageway patching by Solihull MBC Maintenance.

Access **will** be maintained through the site for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies.

Pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of closure.
