The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (A41 Corridor – Various Roads) (20mph and 30mph Maximum Speed Limits) Order 2025

The Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The proposals are:

Proposed Maximum 20mph Speed Limit (to replace existing Maximum 30mph Speed Limit)

The entire lengths of - Seven Star Road service road (fronting 55 to 171), Seven Star Road service road (36 to its junction with Thornby Avenue), Baginton Close, Beauchamp Road, Manor Road and Thornby Avenue.

Proposed Maximum 30mph Speed Limit (to replace existing Maximum 40mph Speed Limit)

Lode Lane - From a point 15m south of its junction with Seven Star Road, to a point 15m north of that junction.

Seven Star Road - From its junction with Lode Lane, in a westerly direction for approx. 790m.

Solihull Bypass - From its junction with Lode Lane, in an easterly direction for approx. 46m.
