

Notice of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations

1. Notice is hereby given that Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council (“the Council”) is conducting a review of the polling districts, polling places and polling stations that fall within the Borough of Solihull, as is required under the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013.
2. Electors within the Borough or Parliamentary Constituencies of Solihull West and Shirley, Meriden and Solihull East and Birmingham Hodge Hill and Solihull North may make representations.
3. The Council would welcome the views of all residents, any local community groups and any person or body with expertise in access to premises for persons with any type of disability on the current arrangements and the (Acting) Returning Officers (ARO) proposals, or any other matter.
4. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
