



NHS COVID-19 app Your privacy protected





The app cannot personally identify you

It cannot access your phone contacts or any other personal data stored on your phone, such as your name, photos, email addresses or phone numbers.



The app cannot be used by law enforcement

All data in the app is stored on your phone. The NHS and the government do not have access to any of this data and cannot monitor or identify you.



The app cannot track your location

The app tracks the virus and not the person. It does not know where you are or whether or not you are following any advice to self-isolate. The app uses Bluetooth Low Energy to measure how far apart you have been from other app users and for how long.



You can choose to delete your data or the app

You can see all of the data that is stored on your phone and you can choose to delete this data or the app at any time. You do not have to use the app or any of its features, but the more of us who do, the easier it will be to stop the spread of the virus.

The app gives you the control:



You choose to download the app



You choose which parts of the app you want to use



You choose when to delete the app
