The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Manor Square, Solihull) (Prohibition of Loading and Unloading) Order 2011

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Council proposes to make this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The Order, if implemented, will introduce a total prohibition of loading and unloading along the following:-

<u>Manor Square</u> – All of the northern side; and on the southern side from its junction with Church Hill Road in a westerly direction for approximately 41 metres; and from a point approximately 52 metres west of its junction with Church Hill Road in a westerly direction for the remainder of its length.

<u>Council House Car Park Access Road</u> - On both sides from its junction with Manor Square to the Council House Car Park access barrier, a distance of approximately 25 metres.

The effect of this amendment will be to prevent loading/unloading from occurring at any time within Manor Square in the interests of road safety. The 3 existing Disabled Persons Parking Spaces that are accessed off Manor Square will not be affected by this proposal.
