You may want to personalise your ceremony and this document provides some guidance on how this can be done.

Declaratory and Contracting Words

These are the words and vows that every couple must say in order for their ceremony to be legally binding. You will need to choose one of the 9 versions shown below. As they form the legal basis of the marriage or partnership ceremony, each version must be used in its entirety in the form shown without alteration. The couple must say the same version.

1.	Declaratory Words I do solemnly declare that I know not of any lawful impediment why may not be joined in matrimony to	AND	Contracting Words I call upon these persons here present to witness that I,, do take thee, to be my lawful wedded wife (or husband)
2.	I do solemnly declare that I know not of any lawful impediment why I,, may not be joined in matrimony to	AND	I, take you, to be my wedded wife (or husband)
3.	I do solemnly declare that I know not of any lawful impediment why I,, may not be joined in matrimony to	AND	I, take thee, to be my wedded wife (or husband)
4.	I declare that I know of no legal reason why I,, may not be joined in marriage to	AND	I call upon these persons here present to witness that I,, do take thee, to be my lawful wedded wife (or husband)
5.	I declare that I know of no legal reason why I,, may not be joined in marriage to	AND	I, take you, to be my wedded wife (or husband)
6.	I declare that I know of no legal reason why I,, may not be joined in marriage to	AND	I, take thee, to be my wedded wife (or husband)
7.	By replying "I am" to the question "Are you, free lawfully to marry?"	AND	I call upon these persons here present to witness that I,, do take thee, to be my lawful wedded wife (or husband)
8.	by replying "I am" to the question: "Are you, free lawfully to marry?"	AND	I, take you, to be my wedded wife (or husband)
9.	by replying "I am" to the question: "Are you, free lawfully to marry?"	AND	I, take thee, to be my wedded wife (or husband)

Vows and Readings

As well as the legal words above, you may wish to personalise your ceremony by including vows and readings and below are some suggestions. However if you would prefer to use your own please discuss this with a member of the Team at least 4 weeks before the event.

The Registrar will be more than happy to read any poems or readings that you choose unless a member of you party wishes to do so.

Suggested Vows

1	I give you this ring as a token of our future lives together. I promise to be loving, to be faithful and to be loyal to you in living our lives together. This ring is the symbol of unity in which our two lives are now joined in one unbroken circle, in which wherever we go, we will always return to one another.
2	I promise to care for you with love and friendship. To support and comfort you through the good times and through troubled times,
3	I promise to care for you with love and with patience. To respect and cherish you and be faithful always. These promises I make to you for the rest of my life.
4	I promise to give you the best of myself and to ask no more than you can give in return
5	I promise to accept you the way you are, for the qualities, abilities and outlook on life that you have. I will not try to change or shape you into any different image
6	I promise to share with you my time and close attention and to bring joy, strength and imagination to our relationship
7	I promise to keep myself open to you and let you see into my innermost fears, feelings, secrets and dreams.
8	I promise to love you with all I feel inside, completely and forever.
9	Let us love and cherish one another. We have given our hearts and let us stand together. We were born to this world and shall always be together in our path through our lives.
10	I am so entirely yours, that if I might have all the world given to me, i could not be happy but in your love.
