## Conditions and Regulations for Nest Boxes

- All nest boxes are the property of Solihull MBC, the 5 year lease agreement is for the plaque on the box only
- Memorials can take up to 8 weeks to be manufactured
- The areas around the box must not be decorated with items such as vases, flower containers, ornaments or wind chimes, these will be removed by the cemetery
- Nest boxes are allocated on a plan and the final position of all boxes is at the discretion of the Manager
- Solihull Council reserve the right to amend the Cemetery and Crematorium Regulations, the design of the boxes and the position of the boxes without notice to lease holders
- Leaseholders must not carry out any work to the box, such as the application of paint or adornments. Costs for the removal of paint or for a replacement box will be passed onto the leaseholder
- If you change your name or address during the period of the lease it is your responsibility to notify the cemetery
- At the end of your lease you may renew
