

Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council – School Organisation Proposals

Proposals to create Additionally Resourced Centres attached to Dickens Heath Primary, Windy Arbor Primary and Yew Tree Primary Schools.

Notice is given in accordance with the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Solihull Council proposes to make prescribed alterations, through the creation of additionally resourced centres attached to Dickens Heath, Yew Tree and Windy Arbor Primary Schools.

School	Current Net Capacity	Additionally Resourced Centre Capacity
Dickens Heath Primary School	420	7 places from 1 September 2016 increasing to 14 places from 1 September 2017
Windy Arbor Primary School	420	14 places from 1 April 2018
Yew Tree Primary School	210	7 places from 1 September 2016

The additionally resourced centres at Dickens Heath and Windy Arbor Primary Schools will cater for pupils with Autistic Spectrum Disorder and will be a key part of the Borough wide strategy. The additionally resourced centre at Yew Tree Primary School will cater for pupils with Social Emotional and Mental Health needs in a small and nurturing environment.

Expansion of the buildings of all of the schools is required to provide the additional accommodation necessary to support these proposals. No change is proposed to the admission arrangements for these schools.
