

By rail

Solihull is served by three passenger railway lines;

Solihull railway station on the Birmingham to Marylebone line, is about ten minutes walk from the Council House.

The Birmingham to Euston line is approximately five miles from the town centre, the nearest station being Birmingham International located near to the NEC.

Shirley Station, on the Birmingham to Stratfordupon-Avon line, is some four miles from Solihull town centre.

By bus

To M42 (JUNC 5) NEC AIRPORT

By car

There is no public parking at around the Council House. Postcode for Sat Nav only B91 3PX
Leave the M42 at junction 5 (Solihull) and take the A41 towards Solihull Town Centre. Take the first left and then the second turning at the roundabout onto the Warwick Road. Continue straight on at the first traffic lights. At the second traffic lights take the left slip road into New Road. Continue along New Road and past St. Alphege Church to a mini-roundabout. Go straight over and down Church Hill road to a roundabout and follow the signs to the nearest public parking at either Touchwood or Church Hill Road.
