## Standing for election

If you are interested in standing as a Borough Council councillor on the day of Nomination and forward to date of poll, you must

- a) be at least 18 years old
- b) be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of any other member state of the European Union
- c) meet at least one of the following four qualifications:
  - I. You are, and will continue to be, registered as a local government elector for the borough in which you wish to stand
  - II. You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the borough during the whole of the preceding 12 months
  - III. Your main or only place of work during the 12 months has been in the borough
  - IV. You have lived in the borough during the whole of the 12 preceding months

## Standing as a Parish Councillor

If you are interested in standing as a parish councillor on the day of Nomination and forward to date of poll, you must

- a) be at least 18 years old
- b) be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of any other member state of the European Union
- c) meet at least **one** of the following four qualifications:
  - I. you are, and will continue to be, registered as a local government elector for the parish/community in which you wish to stand
  - II. you have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the parish/community area during the whole of the preceding 12 months
  - III. your main or only place of work during the 12 months has been in the parish/community
  - IV. you have lived in the parish/community area or within three miles of it during the whole of the 12 preceding months
