| to and over the footpath would include the following: • Heavy plant crossing continuously and a haulage road built through the footpath • Open deep excavation (3m minimum) through the footpath. • Pipeline welding. • Heavy lifting, welding, grinding and grit blasting work will also be going on next to the footpath. (Refer to attached document titled overview of construction work for pictorial representation of works). Various options for the diversion of footpath, such as over the trench have been considered. These however have been discounted on safety ground. Considering the nature of the construction works, the low usage of the PRoW, and the limitation on alternative routes BPA and LMJV have come to the conclusion that closure during working hours is the best solution. The contractors will ensure that the PROW is available and safe for use outside working hours. During consultation and review, representatives of Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council have provided approval in principle for the proposal.
