Statement of Evidence for Path Claim SAP 50


The original path, from Dove House Lane to public footpath U17/U18, with its continuation south-east to Warwick Road (RA ref. SAP 12), is shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1888), with the northern end being shown as a road, or lane.

Most of this continuation was replaced by the construction of Woodfield Road/Thornby Avenue/Manor Road along its line. The northern end, however, was diverted between Buryfield Road and U117/U118 by the Stopping up of Highways (Warwickshire)(no.2) Order 1953 under the Town and Country Planning Act 1947. (Advert in London Gazette No.79827 p.2123 (S.I. 616).)

This diversion route does not now exist, and the section of the route north along the edge of the golf course is also not now accessible. No Highways Order closing these sections of path has been found, however, but this may have taken place when the link path was created to Rowlands Crescent.

This remaining path has a good, tarmac, surface with concrete lighting columns, the link having cycle barriers at both ends. There is also a 'no cycling' roundel at Rowlands Crescent and a 'no dog fouling' notice at the junction.

It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
