Statement of Evidence for Path Claim SAP 77

- The route is shown, but not labelled, on he first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1887).
- The whole route (shown as public footpath M85) was affected by The Stopping up of Highways (County of Warwick)(No.20) Order, 1957 (S.I.1957, No.2033). By this Order, the then Minister "authorised" the closure of the path, and the creation of a short replacement link at the north-east end with much of the remainder of the path being diverted onto proposed estate roads. The estate road (Fordbridge Road), however, only met the path part way along it. If the remainder of the path was closed, this would mean that three paths in Birmingham, coming up to the then City boundary, would be culs-de-sac. A site visit, however, shows that the path beyond Fordbridge Road is well maintained and heavily used with the linking paths (now partly in Solihull and partly in Birmingham) also being in use. [See RA claims SAP 78 + 79]
- The created path link was shown on the Ordnance Survey Pathfinder map (sheet 934) (SP08/18) of 1986 as a public footpath, but is not shown on the 1993 Solihull Definitive Map. No Extinguishment Order for this path link has been found.
- It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the routes subsist as public footpaths and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
