Reviewing the Plan for Solihull's Future – Scope, Issues and Options Consultation

It is important that councils have an up-to-date local plan in place. This is so that the development needed for their area can be met whilst preserving its character. The production of a local plan allows communities to shape the way that their area changes and is used.

The Council's existing local plan was adopted in 2013 and is now in need of review. This consultation marks the start of the process. The consultation responses will help the Council prepare a draft plan with a preferred option in 2016. A final version of the reviewed local plan will be published in 2017, before it is examined by an independent Inspector.

Guidance on completing the form

A series of questions are set out in the full consultation document to help guide those wishing to provide comments. The Council is seeking views on the period that the Solihull Local Plan Review should cover; the evidence base to be prepared; cross boundary and strategic issues that will need to be addressed; the key challenges that the Borough faces; the level of growth that should be provided for; and the opportunities that exist to accommodate this growth. However, views on the content of the review more generally are also welcomed.
