You should share any concerns about children and young people's safety and well-being with your named or designated member of staff (depending on the organisational setting), or with a manager or senior colleague. This will help you decide what action should be taken, and provide you with some support.

Never delay action to safeguard a child or young person

Children and young people may be harmed by:-

- Physical abuse
- Sexual abuse
- Neglect
- Emotional abuse

Research tells us that we should also pay careful attention to the needs of children and young people where there is:-

Domestic violence and abuse in the family • A parent who misuses drugs or alcohol • A parent with a mental illness
