We have a group of Young Carers' called the DMG that meet regularly to make decisions about how the service is run.

SUPPORT WORKERS

We have Support Workers at the service who are able to help you with:

- Sign Posting (finding you other services that can help)
- Advocacy (speak to people on your behalf)
- A One To One (speak to somebody in private about how you feel)
- School And Homework (we can help you with school issues)

ACTIVITIES AND DAYS OUT

Meet with other young carers on trips out, especially during the holiday times.

YOUNG CARER DEFINITION

You may be a 'young carer' if you are aged 5 to 18 and look after someone (family member or friend) who has an illness, disability, mental health condition, alcohol/ substance dependancy or HIV/AIDS. Young carers take on practical and/or emotional caring responsibilities that would normally be expected of an adult.
