- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 8 June.
- 6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 22 May.
- 7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB by 5 p.m. on Tuesday 23 May.
- Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB by 5 p.m. on Wednesday 31 May.
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council House, Manor Square, Solihull, West Midlands, B91 3QB by 5 p.m. on Thursday 8 June. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 31 May.
